

ORDINANCE NUMBER 122

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AND PERMITTING THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF SANTA CLARA THE USE OF MAIN STREET BETWEEN THE NORTHERLY LINE OF PALO ALTO AVENUE, AND THE NORTHERLY LINE OF WASHINGTON AVENUE FOR THE PURPOSE OF CONSTRUCTING THEREON A HIGHWAY.

THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF MAYFIELD DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I The Board of Supervisors of the County of Santa Clara is hereby permitted the use of Main Street in the Town of Mayfield **between** the northerly line of Palo Alto Avenue and the northerly line of Washington Avenue, a distance of 2007.65 feet, for the purpose of constructing thereon a highway as part of a county and state system of roads.

SECTION II Said Board of Supervisors shall have power hereunder to pave such highway in such manner as it may be determined, the costs thereof to be paid out of the General Fund of the County Treasury of said County of Santa Clara, but neither said Board of Supervisors nor said County of Santa Clara shall be under any obligation after said paving is completed to further improve or maintain said highway.

SECTION III This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty days after its passage and approval, and shall be published in *The Mayfield News* a newspaper published in said Town of Mayfield as required by law.
