

ORDINANCE #44.

An ordinance authorizing and permitting the Board of Supervisors of the County of Santa Clara the use of the First Street Road commencing at the intersection of the Milpitas Road, thence running West to the intersection of Liberty Street, also Taylor Street commencing at the intersection of Liberty Street and running West to El-Dorado Street, also El-Dorado Street, Commencing at the intersection of Taylor Street, thence South to the Guadalupe River for the purpose of constructing thereon a county highway.

The Town Board of Alviso do ordain as follows;

Section 1- The Board of Supervisors of the County of Santa Clara is hereby permitted the use of the above named road and streets for the purpose of constructing thereon a county highway as part of a county system of roads.

Section 2- Said Board of Supervisors shall have power hereunder to macadamize, pave or gutter such highway in such manner as it may determine the cost thereof to be paid out of the general fund of the county treasury, but said Board of Supervisors shall be under no obligations after said improvement is completed to maintain or further improve said highway.

Section 3- This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty days after its passage and approval and shall be published by The Post of San Jose, Calif.
