#### **GOVERNMENT CODE SECTION 87200 FILERS**

The following positions are not subject to the County’s code. Instead, these positions are designated in Government Code section 87200 as positions that are subject to the disclosure requirements of the Political Reform Act and are required to file full Statements of Economic Interests. These positions are listed here for informational purposes only.

- (1) Member of the Board of Supervisors
- (2) District Attorney
- (3) County Counsel
- (4) County Executive
- (5) Finance Agency Director (*ex officio* Treasurer)
- (6) Member of Planning Commission

Pursuant to Government Code section 87200, officials who manage public investments as defined by 2 California Code of Regulations § 18701(b) are also subject to the disclosure requirements of the Political Reform Act and are required to file full Statements of Economic Interests. The County has determined that the holders of the positions listed below are officials who manage public investments.

- (7) Assistant Controller-Treasurer
- (8) Controller/Treasurer
- (9) County Treasury Administrator
- (10) Fixed Income Portfolio Manager
- (11) Securities Analyst
- (12) Treasury Coordinator
- (13) County of Santa Clara Defined Contribution Plans Committee Member
- (14) County of Santa Clara Defined Contribution Plans Committee Alternate to Finance Agency Director
- (15) County Treasury Oversight Committee Member

Government Code section 87200 filers shall file Statements of Economic Interests with the Clerk of the Board, the filing official.
